Note: Nov. 15 - Dec. 24 are fast days during which we are encouraged to fast from meat and dairy. On Saturday and Sunday, as well as on certain weekday feast days, fish, wine, and oil are okay. On Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday, wine and oil are okay. Wednesday and Friday, as well as the week preceding Christmas as stricter fast days. To receive Communion on Christmas, one should go to Confession during Advent. Appointments are made by using the schedule book located in the Narthex.
