





THE TWELVE GREAT FEASTS FOR CHILDREN series:

In the Orthodox Church Year, the Feast of Feasts, in a class by itself, is the Resurrection. After the Resurrection in importance come the twelve Great Feasts. These feasts are the Church's celebration of, and participation in, key events leading to our salvation. The Great Feasts are often separated into Feasts of the Lord and Feasts of the Theotokos.

Nativity of Our Lord (Christmas)
Theophany of Our Lord (Epiphany)
Entry of Our Lord into Jerusalem (Palm Sunday)
Ascension of Our Lord
Pentecost
Transfiguration of Our Lord


Feasts of the Theotokos

Entry of the Theotokos into the Temple
Meeting of Our Lord*

(Presentation of Christ in the Temple)
Annunciation
Dormition of the Theotokos

* The Meeting of Our Lord is also considered a Feast of the Lord


A final note - Theotokos, an ancient title for the Virgin Mary, means "birthgiver of God." Used since at least the third century, this title guards the truth that Mary's Son is not only fully human, but fully God.






























